



Application Type C: EVENTS

The Trust has a long history of supporting international events that bring the scientific community together to share and disseminate research. We value the opportunity these gatherings provide for exchanging knowledge, and the following guidelines are designed to help you demonstrate how your event aligns with the Trust's priorities.

- What is the overall aim of your proposed event – what do you want to achieve?
- What is the duration and the expected size of the targeted audience.
- How are you promoting the event?
- Include a detailed programme of the conference content with respective speakers – this will demonstrate to the trustees the extent of planning and appropriateness of that event.
- If your application is successful how will the Trust be recognised for their support?
- Provide financial information including a breakdown. Some applicants request a contribution towards their event, rather than the total cost, therefore explaining precisely how the grant will be used will aid our decision process.

We do not support the following:

- Meetings to disseminate basic information during beekeeping courses
- Beekeeping courses
- Celebrations such as National Bee Day
- Events for school children
